

Standard Contract

I, _____, on this date of _____ do hereby agree to the following rules in acceptance of my role in (insert Show Name). My parent and I have read and understand all the following rules and will adhere to them or forfeit participation in the play.

I agree to:

- Maintain at least a C average during the rehearsal period in ALL subject areas.
- Not miss scheduled rehearsals during, before or after school.
- Be safe and use props and weapons with the utmost respect and care.
- Always arrive on time, appropriately dressed, with script, pencil and work to do during downtime.
- Not talk when group is rehearsing.
- Save non-play related questions for the director until the beginning or end of rehearsal.
- Focus on the Director and student assistants when they are talking.
- Memorize my lines by deadlines.
- Write my blocking and choreography down in my script.
- No gum, candy, food or drink (other than water).
- When not on-stage rehearsing, quietly read, do homework, study lines or quiet work.
- I will commit to assist Kimberly in finding simple costume pieces for my character.
- **Read this contract to a parent, sign below and return this contract to Mr. Beckett.**

In regards to my fellow artists I will:

- Show respect for all members of the show.
- Not direct other actors. That is the director's job.
- Not harass or tease other actors.
- Not put down other actors.
- Not boss other actors around. That is the stage manager's job.

If I break the above rules I will be subject to the following **Consequences** process

- 1.Warning
- 2.Asked to go home for the day.
- 3.Out of play

Rehearsals will be held after school. I will make arrangements with Mr. Beckett for any conflicts with the schedule in the first week of rehearsal or, at the latest, one week in advance.

My parent and I will schedule all orthodontic, dental, and medical appointments around the schedule. Other than emergencies, last minute conflicts will not be honored and will count as a missed rehearsal and risks my participation in the show.

Technical Rehearsals in the last week of February and the first week of March will be from 3:00 to 6:00 PM everyday and are very important. There will be NO conflicts allowed for those days.
